Focus Music gives your students access to learn a musical instrument at school – no experience necessary, learning from experienced instrumental teachers.

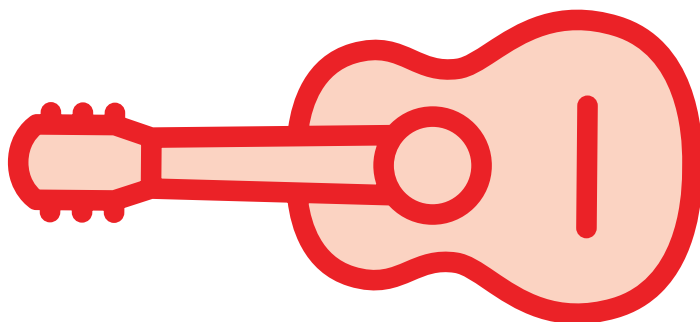

Focus Music staff will attend your school to deliver the lessons.

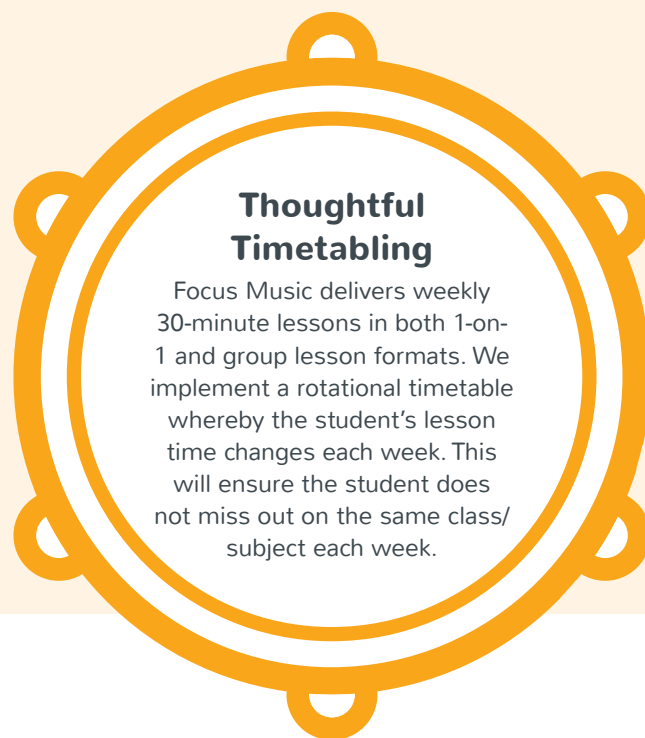


Experience
